

JR Chikugo-Yoshii Station Coin Locker Terms of Use

Article 1 (Operating Hours)

The coin lockers are available 24 hours a day.

Article 2 (Fees)

Locker usage fees are ¥300 for small lockers, ¥500 for medium lockers, and ¥700 for large lockers.

Article 3 (Storage Period)

After midnight, the next day's basic fee will be added. The maximum continuous usage period is 72 hours.

Article 4 (Payment Methods)

Cash, credit cards, and electronic payments (such as PayPay) are accepted.

Article 5 (Handling of Receipts)

1. A receipt with a QR code issued at the time of use is required to unlock the locker.
2. **[Important: Please take a photo of your receipt in case of loss. Depending on lighting reflections, the QR code may not scan properly, so please take several photos with different lighting adjustments.]**

Article 6 (Response to Lost Receipts)

1. Chikugo-Yoshii Station staff hours: 7:00-15:35 (Open year-round)
2. Support will only be provided to the person who lost the receipt.
3. Depending on station staff workload, immediate response may not be possible.
4. Please note that no support is available when station staff are absent.

Article 7 (Prohibited Items)

1. Storage of dangerous materials, illegal items, or living organisms
2. Storage of valuables (the city assumes no responsibility for theft or loss)
3. Damaging lockers or unauthorized use

Article 8 (Disclaimer)

1. The city and JR assume no responsibility for theft, loss, or damage to items, regardless of the reason.
2. The city and JR assume no responsibility, including refunds, in cases where lockers become unusable due to natural disasters, malfunctions, etc.
3. The city and JR assume no responsibility for delays in unlocking or inconvenience caused by lost receipts.
